#### **Minutes**

Motion was made to approve the minutes of the previous meetings of April 9, 2018, as written, motion second, motion passed.

### **Treasurers Report**

Ron gave the finical overview report, going over all monies in the operating and reserve accounts. As of June 30, 2018, in the operating account there is \$54,236.10, and in the reserve account there is \$303,210.77. For the year the association is \$1,613.84 over budget. Mostly in irrigation repairs.

#### **New Business**

Tree Trimming – After review of tree trimming proposals from R & R Tree and Rock & Rose Tree, it was decided that, because the proposals are so far apart from each other, management and the president will walk the property with Rock & Rose to see what they are including in their proposal. Board agreed that when Rock & Rose resubmit their proposal and it is still substantially lower than R & R Tree, the president can sign the updated proposal to get the trees trimmed.

Paint Reserve – Management pointed out to the Board that a paint reserve is not included in the reserve account. Board is thinking that the buildings should be painted in two years' time. Two options. 1. Make a special assessment to the owners for the cost of the painting. 2. Increase the monthly assessment in 2019 with the increase going to a paint reserve. Management will get a paint spec from Sherwin-Williams paint and get a proposal to paint the property, so the Board will have an idea what the cost would be.

Parking – The Board, once again, made it clear that any owner who has a guest stay over for the night, or for a few days, must call the towing company and register the vehicle and get an overnight parking pass, or the vehicle will be towed from the property at the owner's expense.
